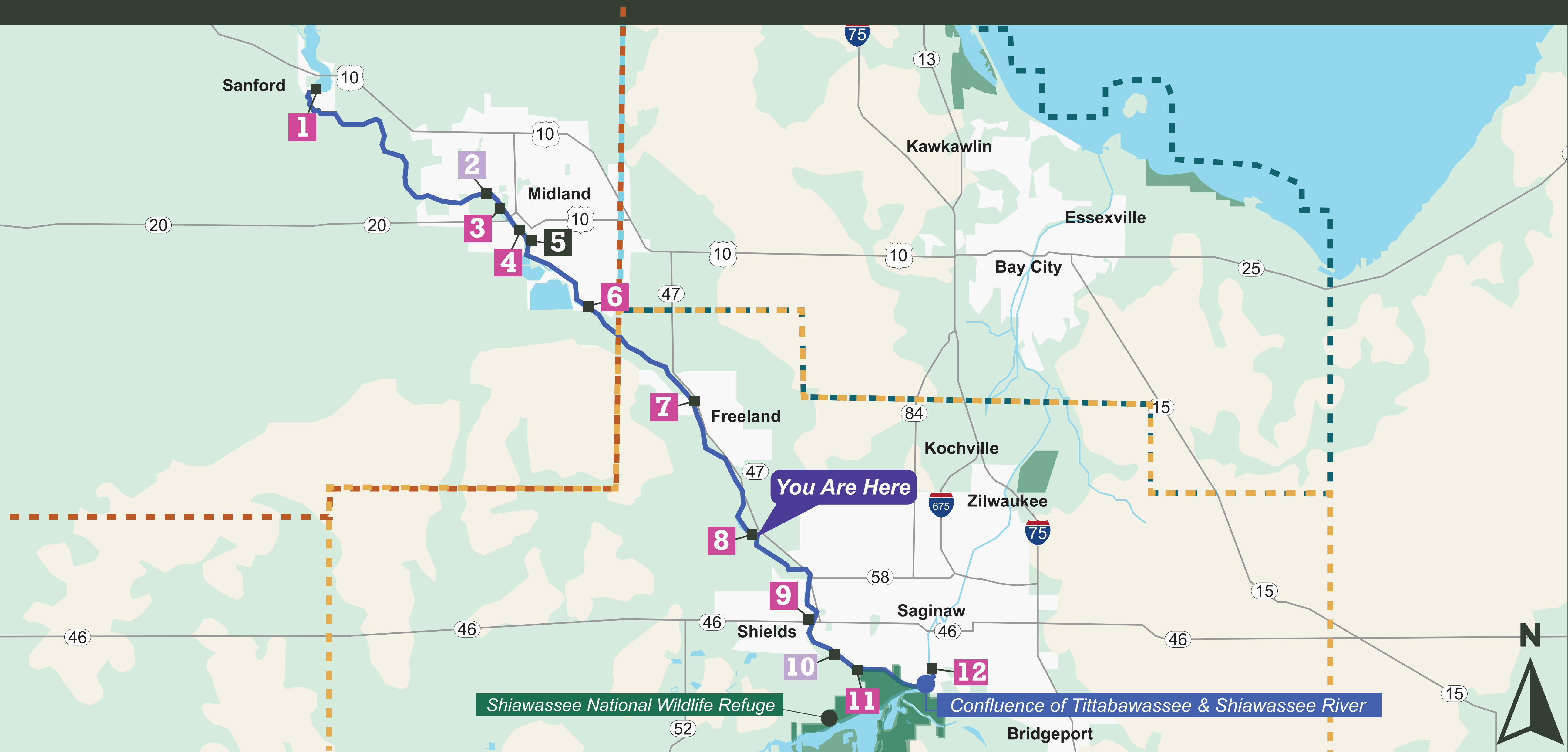


# Tittabawassee River Water Trail
