Michigan Disaster Recovery Center – Saginaw County

Residents affected by the severe storms that struck the area in April 2026 have an opportunity to receive in-person assistance at the Disaster Recovery Center (DRC) opening in Saginaw County.

Representatives from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) will be available to answer questions, explain available disaster assistance programs, and help eligible residents complete applications for FEMA assistance and SBA disaster loans.

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Residents do not need to visit the Disaster Recovery Center to apply for assistance. However, those who have questions about their applications, need help completing required documentation, or would like to speak directly with FEMA or SBA specialists are encouraged to visit the center during operating hours.

Individuals who believe they sustained losses because of the April 2026 severe storms are encouraged to register as soon as possible to determine their eligibility for available federal disaster assistance programs.

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
